GOD + COFFEE

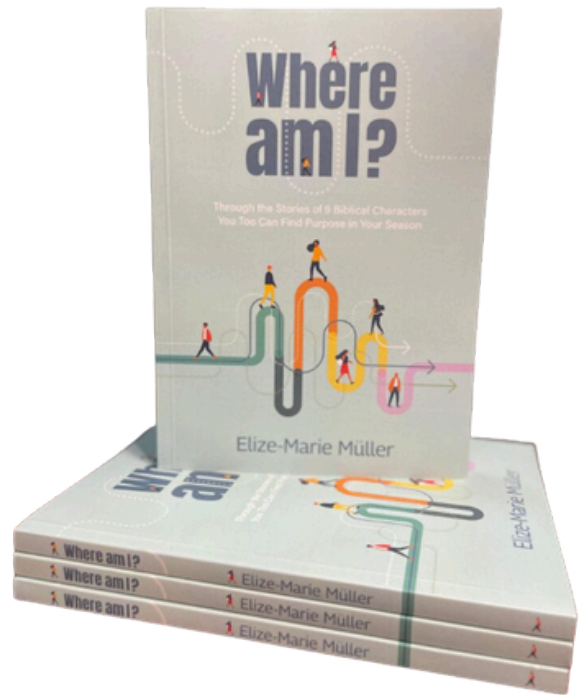
